## Crocheted Capelet LM0175

### One Size Fits Most Women.

**MODA DEA™ "Bow Ties™"**, Art. R135 (1.76 ounce/67 yard ball): 3 Balls No. 3738 Pink Lady **CA**, 2 balls No. 3735 Flirt **CB**.

**Crochet Hooks:** 9mm [US M-13] and 10mm [US N-15].  
Yarn needle.

**GAUGE:** 7 dc = 4"; 7 rows = 6 1/2" in pat with larger hook. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.**

Finished Length: 14"

**Neck Circumference:** 23".

**Lower Circumference:** 74".

**To Change Color in Dc:** With color in use yo and draw up a lp in last st of row, yo and draw yarn through 2 lps, drop color in use; with next color to be used yo and draw through 2 lps remaining on hook.

With larger hook and **CA**, ch 39.

**Row 1:** Dc in 4th ch from hook and in each ch across changing to **CB** in last st; turn – 37 sts.

**Row 2:** With **CB**, ch 4, dc in first dc (beg V-st), \* skip next dc; (*dc, ch 1, dc*) all in next dc – **V-st** made; rep from \* across working last V-st in top of ch-3; turn – 19 V-sts.

**Row 3:** With **CB**, (sl st, ch 4, dc) all in first ch-1 sp, \* V-st in next ch-1 sp; rep from \* across changing to **CA** in last st; turn.

**Row 4:** With **CA**, (sl st, ch 3, dc) all in first sp, \* dc in next dc, yo and draw up a lp in next dc, yo and draw through 2 lps, skip next sp, yo and draw up a lp in next dc, yo and draw through 2 lps, yo and draw through 3 lps on hook, dc in next dc \*\*, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp; rep from \* to last sp, end at \*\*, 2 dc in last sp; turn – 55 sts.

**Row 5:** With **CA**, ch 3, dc in first dc, \* dc in next dc, [yo and draw up a lp in next st, yo and draw through 2 lps] 3 times, yo and draw through all 4 lps on hook, dc in next dc \*\*, 3 dc in next dc; rep from \* to last st, end at \*\*, 2 dc in top of ch-3 changing to **CB** in last st; turn.

**Rows 6 and 7:** With **CB**, rep Rows 2 and 3 – 28 V-sts.

**Row 8:** With **CA**, (sl st, ch 3, dc) all in first sp, \* dc in next 3 sts, [yo and draw up a lp in next dc, yo and draw through 2 lps] twice, yo and draw through all 3 lps on hook, dc in next 3 sts \*\*, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp; rep from \* to last sp, end at \*\*, 2 dc in last sp; turn – 91 sts.

**Row 9:** With **CA**, ch 3, dc in first dc, \* dc in next 3 dc, [yo and draw up a lp in next st, yo and draw through 2 lps] 3 times, yo and draw through all 4 lps on hook, dc in next 3 dc \*\*, 3 dc in next dc; rep from \* to last st, end at \*\*, 2 dc in top of ch-3 changing to **CB** in last st; turn.

**Rows 10 and 11:** With **CB**, rep Rows 2 and 3 – 46 V-sts.

**Row 12:** With **CA**, (sl st, ch 3, dc) all in first sp, \* dc in next 5 sts, yo and draw up a lp in next sp, yo and draw through 2 lps, skip next 2 dc, yo and draw up a lp in next sp, yo and draw through 2 lps, yo and draw through all 3 lps on hook, dc in next 5 sts \*\*, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp; rep from \* to last sp, end at \*\*, 2 dc in last sp; turn – 127 sts.

**Row 13:** With **CA**, ch 3, dc in first dc, \* dc in next 5 dc, [yo and draw up a lp in next st, yo and draw through 2 lps] 3 times, yo and draw through all 4 lps on hook, dc in next 5 dc \*\*, 3 dc in next dc; rep from \* to last st, end at \*\*, 2 dc in top of ch-3. Fasten off.

**FRONT & NECK EDGING-Row 1:** With right side facing and smaller hook, attach **CA** at bottom of right front opening; ch 1, sc evenly up front working an even number of sts, work 3 sc in corner, sc evenly around neck working an odd number of sts, work 3 sc in corner, sc evenly down left front working an even number of sts; turn.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, \* (sc, ch 2, dc) all in first sc, skip next sc; rep from \* up left front to 3-sc corner; \*\* (sc, ch 2, dc) in each of next 3 sc \*\*, skip next sc; rep from \* around neck to next 3-sc corner; rep from \*\* to \*\* once; skip next sc; rep from \* down right front to last sc; sc in last sc. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

**TIES:** Cut 6 strands of **CB** 22" long. Attach 3 strands evenly spaced down each front opening. Tie in bows; trim ends.

**ABBREVIATIONS:** beg = beginning; ch = chain; dc = double crochet; lp(s) = loop (s); rep = repeat; sc = single crochet; sl st = slip stitch; sp = space; st(s) = stitch (es); yo = yarn over; \* or \*\* = repeat whatever follows the \* or \*\* as indicated; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
